





## **QPTV Presents:** The Light Millennium "Peace: Reality or Utopian Dream?"









## QPTV Presents: The Light Millennium "GREEN-CLEAN ECONOMY AND POWER FOR ALL"
















Environmentally irresponsible economical practices are showing their effects all around the world through global warming, pollution, and destruction of natural resources. The urgency of such problems demands immediate action. However, things are not easy. Due to seemingly high costs, firms and governments shirk away from implementing preventative measures against global warming. Therefore, the key question is: Can Green-Clean Economy be a solution?

This program explores this concept from multiple angles through representatives from the UN – International Labor Organization, universities, international NGOs, street interviews with concerned citizens, and student-level presentations both in person and via a survey, which was undertaken by Andrea S.
